It's a unique and memorable setting for relaxed celebrations, overlooking an idyllic, sheltered corner of St Ives bay. The café is perfect for smaller weddings and for intimate events for groups of up to 50 people.

Unfortunately, we don't hire the cafe during the Easter holidays, July & August, Christmas week or over Bank Holidays.

The Location

There can be few other places in the UK where your guests will want to kick off their shoes and enjoy a paddle, where the wedding couple can indulge in a game of beach cricket, and where seals and dolphins might drop by to join in the fun.

Porthgwidden Beach Café is in the historic heart of St Ives and is surrounded by old fishing cottages and artists' studios. Winding, cobbled streets lead to our sandy, sheltered bay, which is popular with families in the summer. Despite being right in the thick of things we have a car park just behind the café, which is very useful for the arrival and departure of the wedding party and guests.

The Space

Let the sand, sea and sky be your wedding décor, with a view like this you'll need very few embellishments to create an impression. Whether you dream of a simple elopement-style wedding with just the two of you and a few special guests, or a larger gathering of family and friends, the view from our venue has the ultimate wow factor. Whatever the weather, the backdrop is a wedding photographer's dream! You will have exclusive use of the café during your time with us, whether you opt for whole day or just evening use. Inside is a bar area, cosy seating and a huge picture window overlooking the beach. This leads on to our fully-enclosed glass terrace, which can be heated in cooler weather or opened up to become a beautiful sun deck; it's a flexible space which allows you to get the most out of this special beach-side location.

License

Porthgwidden Beach Café has a full license to hold legal Wedding Ceremonies (Civil Marriages and Civil Partnerships) as granted by Cornwall Council. We also host Celebratory Ceremonies (non-legal ceremonies) and renewals of vows. Couples will need to book the Registrar or Celebrant themselves.



Please find below the answers to some frequently asked questions about marriage and civil partnerships ceremonies at Porthgwidden Beach Café, we hope this answers some of your initial questions.

Venue Capacities

Porthgwidden Café is an exclusive, intimate venue which is perfect for smaller celebrations with close family and friends. The numbers we can accommodate for the various types of event are as follows:

Blessing/Marriage on the terrace -	50 people
Blessing/Marriage in the café -	50 people
Sit down meal in the café -	36 people
Sit down meal using the terrace -	48 people
Sit down meal using the café and the terrace -	50 people
BBQ Buffet or Buffet using the café and the terrace-	50 people

Decorations

We encourage couples to decorate the Café to suit their theme, and we are flexible with regards to the type and quantity of decorating you arrange to undertake in the café or on the terrace. Our wedding planner and team will decorate on the morning of the wedding as per your instructions. Given the beach-side setting, we often find couples choose minimal decoration so the view can take centre-stage, but we can also recommend local wedding stylists if you really want to make an impact with your decorative theme. We provide white linen tablecloths and napkins if required.

Local suppliers

We have a good relationship with local photographers, florists, cake makers, hairdressers and make up artists. Please feel free to enquire and we will be happy to pass on their information.

Food & Drink

Porthgwidden Beach Café must provide all the food and drink consumed in the café or on the beach with the exception of the wedding cake. We have three menu types to choose from and our Head Chef is more than happy to adapt these to suit your wishes. We can cater for special dietary requirements. We do not offer corkage on any drinks.

Accommodation

Although we don't have accommodation at Porthgwidden Beach Café, our sister restaurant Porthminster Kitchen on the harbour front has two luxury apartments available. These can be booked through Luxury St Ives who also have other accommodation available within St Ives.

Music

We have a sound system that can play background music but is not suitable for the evening party. We suggest couples hire a PA system and play their own music or hire a DJ/Band.

Parking

There is a Cornwall Council long stay car park (The Island Car Park) just above the Café. This provides a handy drop-off point for you and your guests. However, St Ives is very busy in the summer (the car park is often full) and we do recommend that you make careful plans for parking and transport on the day for you and your guests.
